 **Bird:** Fulfillment of Wishes, Motherhood, Never Flying.


 **Rooster:** Rich Married Life, Masculine. Life.


 **Poppy:** Joy and Beauty. Beloved Ukrainian Art Motif.


 **Rake:** Harvest, Put things in Order.


 **Flower:** Caring, Beauty, Friendship.

 **Wheat:** Good Health and Good Harvest.

 **Spider:** Perseverance, Patience, and Skill.
